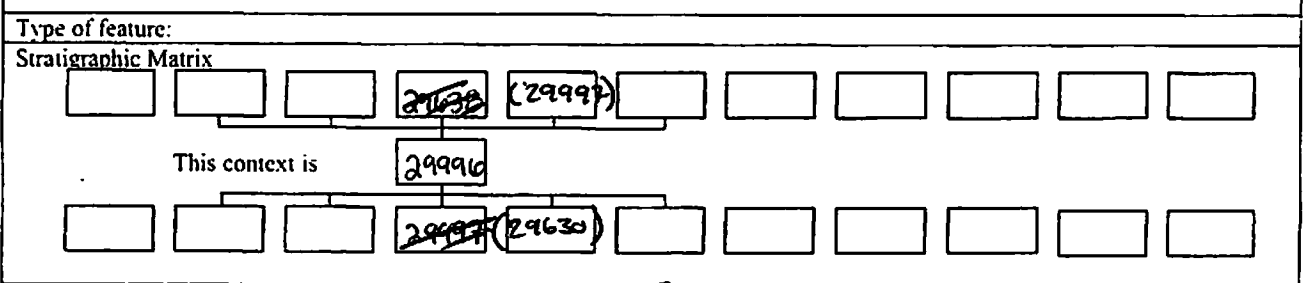

 Rectangular cut on top of limestone debris [29638]. Similar cuts are found w/ the site like [29316] and seem to be areas or rooms possibly associated with burning or cooking. Deposit is rich in ash, silt, and chunks of pottery. In square 527, a round cut, perhaps a hearth, may be associated with it.
