Description: In this stratum we unearthed the fore-mentioned ceramic bundle (with a distinct  $\Phi$  (phi) engraved or stamped onto the surface) as well as a large (c. 20 cm diameter) portion of a neck and enough rim sherds to reconstruct nearly all of the rim of what appears to be the same storage vessel. Cookingware was also excavated (including distinct handle-sherds). Considering the size of the pieces of the "basket handled" storage vessel, we are confident that we are beyond the plow zone in this level.

The neck sherd was found almost adjacent to the west wall of the ~~unit~~ <sup>unit</sup>. There is a distinct sooty deposit in the unit wall right next to it, although the soil "inside" the vessel is not different in any way from that without.

The basket handle with neck and rim fragments was given an FS number (5005-1001).

The wall continues down and cannot determine the ~~exact~~ bottom of it in this SU.

Artifact densities and types between 5005 and 5006 differ slightly. 5005 contained cooking pots and storage vessels while 5006 had a greater assortment.
