Description: Mud Brick continues into layer. Clay-like soil, used large pick to get through tough pockets.

The mud brick has increased and ~~there~~ ~~is~~ some of it has become a little harder (holding together better) and some of it is less red and more brown. Mud bricks are 5 YR 5-8 in Munsell. We came down on a darker layer right below the mudbrick pockets. This will be our next SU. A metal piece was found and given FS# 5011-1001. The location of this metal artifact is shown in ~~5011-D1~~ 5011-D1. It does not appear to be slag and seems to be worked metal. Charcoal was found in the darker layer that starts the next SU. This is right below the mudbrick.

Below the mud brick layer we encountered burned pottery and mud brick. The ^{bottom} ~~edge~~ of the mud brick will mark a new SU. Also it appears there is mortar in this unit as well.

Mud brick that appears to be burnt has appeared and we have more metal than in previous SU's. There also appears to be more cooking pottery.

On the eastern side of the SU, there appears to be rubble mixed with some mortar and green pottery around it.
