Description: This is an ashy soil which contains some bone and a lot of ceramic for how small the area is. It does not continue to bedrock but stops at a SU break. It is concentrated to SE corner of trench and is very loose. Maybe a trash dump of some sort?

SU contained some pottery including a painted piece. The ~~sed~~ sediment was very fine and was excavated mostly with the excavator's hands, not tools. Compared to other units there ~~was~~ ^{was} a higher density of bone.

The SU actually cuts into SU 5017 so it may possibly be a bell-shaped pit or midden of some kind.
