Description:

Unit represents a compacted earth floor immediately above bedrock in the eastern half of the trench. The bedrock slopes down to the west. Pottery levels increased a little and a complete base representing $\approx 50\%$ of a plainware table vessel was found in the SE corner. Unit was very compacted like S108, and contained lots of pebbles. Excavation consisted of the floor surface and $\approx 1-2$ cm of sub floor fill. A $\approx .50 \times .50$ m section of bedrock was exposed on the eastern side of the trench @ 54.65.
