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Description: This small su has lots of large rocks in it which possibly form part of a wall. We are trying to determine which rocks are possibly part of a wall and which are rubble or field rocks. There are several pieces of mortar and plaster scattered throughout the su. We also found a piece of flooring in the North West corner of the area. The piece measured 28 cm long 18 cm wide and 3 1/2 cm deep. (see picture 5209-P1)

We ended this su once we hit a softer richer soil very different from the compacted soil on the top of the su. This soil appears to be very similar to the soil in su ~~5209~~⁵²¹¹ which is ~~at approximately~~ about the same level.
