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Description: This SU was filled with dark very ashy soil. It was very loose and fine, and it was also very obviously contained to one corner of the trench. I found some pieces of burned rock and pottery as well as a piece of lithic. Other than that there was very little pottery found in the SU. I removed a few rocks which possibly form the end of a North South wall which splits the trench extension in half. The ashy layer appears to continue beyond the ~~boundary~~ Southern boundary of the trench. I stopped this SU once I had removed all of the black ashy soil I could, I also may have hit bedrock as the bottom of this layer is marked by a large continuous rock. The final elevation was 55.20
