Description: This SU is fairly compact with darker soil. There are even darker soil patches like those found in SU 5220. There is much more pottery in this SU including an intact base and several shells.

However the pottery count is getting lower and lower as I go down in this SU. I have also found pieces of ~~Asphalt~~ sandstone and a few pieces of what may be plaster. I am encountering larger areas of the dark dark ashy soil especially ~~on~~ along the Western wall. This SU was ended once I hit bedrock across the SU. The end elevations were 55.23 in the East, 55.19 in the West and the bottom elevation was 55.08. (The bedrock formed a hole in the Western area of the SU that looked like a bowl.)
