However, after removing a few cm of soil, we discovered that ~~the~~ a <sup>very</sup> soft soil fill, which was in the place where the mortar bed should have been. It appears that someone dug into the mortar bed - there are many pottery fragments in this area pit. While defining the new SU, we discovered a piece of statuary. We have left this in the fill & will remove it as part of the next SU.
