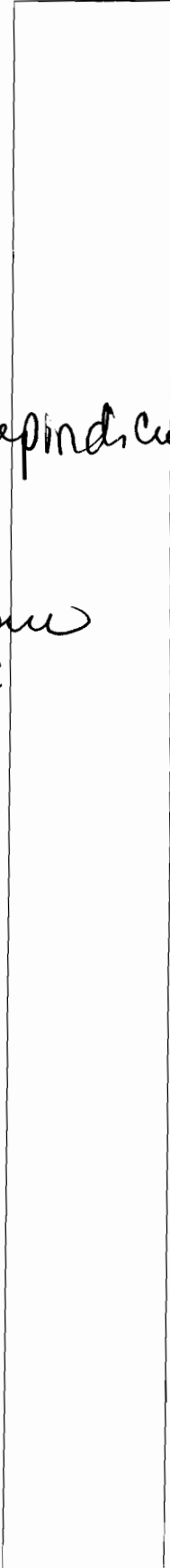

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Description: The ashy patch uncovered in SU5239 and excavated in this SU is not very extensive but does clearly extend into the N Scarp wall. It is on a level with the ash layer near the top of the NE portion of EU2, including a patch that runs up to the wall perpendicularly bisecting EU2. It contains burned sherds and is made of compacted sandy soil looser than the clay above. The S → N slope suggests the ashy area is ~~more~~ more extensive in the scarp, and that the SU5240 is only a portion of the burnt out area.



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
