Description: This SU is a layer of slightly compact, very stony dirt. It has ash inclusions about 2 cm wide throughout the area beneath SU 5242, the rich ash layer. The inclusions are distinct and very dark gray (10YR 4/1).

The SU was ended at 13 cm because of a change in the % of stoniness (less) and lack of clay inclusions. There are many chalky inclusions in the new layer.
