Description:

Came right down on a hard floor. Both FS1001 and FS1002 on surface of floor. The hard floor is approximately 2cm thick, clay, brownish w/ tinges of olive green in color.

(FS5314-1001, huge ceramic sherd; elevation, 54.39; from east wall, 49cm from north wall, 21cm)

(FS5314-1002, coin; elevation, 54.30; from north wall, 75cm from east wall, 93cm)

Iron spit, elevation 54.34cm, resting on eastern face of trench foundation wall, center of wall, on floor.

Going to close out this SU after removed clay floor and now on top of cable sub-floor. Munsell, reddish-yellow soils.
