Description:

Foundation wall placed directly on bedrock without a trench with the subfloor and flooring running directly up to the edge of the wall. Metal linear object found 170cm down (53.99) in southern half of SU 5317. Just above bedrock in northern half, cobble stones were found similar to northern part of 5316. Coin found in northern half with no available elevation due to already disturbed height. Coin came through on the dry screens.
