Description:

This SU is non-stratigraphic & under 5513 & 5515. For safety reasons we extended the trench & stepped it. But the soil is so sandy & loose it came apart easily & we had to roll w/ it. ~~but - ~~but~~~~ ~~but~~ In the end, we "sloped" the "scarp" & created a space to ~~take~~ walk in. We screened everything, swept the floor of the trench, (1 day a bit to be sure).

Part of this SU was still the tumble, but the majority was the deposit, affected by the large body of finds. It's unfortunate that we couldn't be more vertically precise here, but the scarp collapses prevented us from doing so. But, to underscore the point, the context here is identical to rest of deposit - large ceramic frags, stone vessels, even bone.
