Description:

SU 5518 sits ~~in~~ under 5511, in the 1m north extension of under 5504 partially, we've defined it using the hypothesised north wall face on the drawing of 5511/04.

Soft, brown soil which contains almost no cultural material? lots of pebbles. But no tumble layer yet. This seems like wash to me.

Some larger stones begin to turn up lower in the SU, but otherwise the context remains the same - same soil & almost no cultural material, given the size of the SU. Presumably some of this is indeed tumble from the wall now that we're outside it. North face successfully demarcated. SU closed w/ soil or context change.
