Description: This SU commenced immediately under the cobbles
sized floor foundation stones of 5607, which was founded
directly on SU 5608. The soil had a somewhat sticky
appearance, and was low in ceramic density. As it appeared
to undercut wall 5601-F1, an arbitrary break ^{was called} along on the
level of the apparent base course of this wall, with the
idea that this wall was founded on a ^{lower} continuation of
this SU. This SU was thus terminated at this level, giving
chronological and stratigraphic controls on which to base ^{an}
