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Description: This small ridge of excess soil was located directly under the excavated foundation of mudbrick wall 5603-F, and was differentiated from the wall itself by its more compact nature, different feel while trowling, and higher incidence of stray inclusions. Due to the identical levels and similarity of soil, this SU has been declared contemporary with ~~5608~~ SU 5608. The SU was thus excavated to the bottom level of 5608 ready for the excavation of the next EU, 5609, directly underlying the whole area.

NOTE: Further excavation under this SU has revealed the continuation of the mudbrick wall in the same area. This unit is therefore a continuation of the wall 5604 & thus contemporary, and NOT contemporary with 5608 as previously thought.
