Artifact density was low. It  
was moderately stony and requires  
a pick to loosen the area!  
The north part of the North wall  
is more visible. A patch of  
Mudbrick was found. There are  
two rocks that are visible on the  
bottom of the SU. The area extends  
South  $\approx$  20cm from the Northern  
Coordinates of EU 8. It was the  
same fill that was consisted with the  
other SUs in EU 8. It was decided to  
end the SU because there was a  
change in soil color.
