Having completed SU 5717 we have moved north to excavate down to floor in the area between 5717 - f1 and 5702 - f1. Immediately NW of amphora (fs 5716 - 1005) we have come down on a flat round stone. This looks like an artifact and may be associated with the amphora 15 cm to the south.

Description:

New day - Thursday, June 11

Today we are finishing this SU which is really a cleaning layer basket immediately over a large rectangular limestone slab. This SU preserves what was overlying this slab (which we suspect is a second phase of flooring - see notes on SU 5717), but also attempts to define several patches of soft soil along the N-part (S. of wall 5702-F1). After taking the level soil down to level of the top of the slab, we are closing the SU.

We have, however, noted & revealed a ~~small~~ small open bowl in the E-scarp wall 45 cm north of amphora (fs 5716-1005). This lies ~~at~~ at the level of the top of the slab, or, on Phase II floor. We will give this an fs # of fs 5718 - 1003
