Description:

SU-5904 began after an arbitrary break. It became a cleaning SU once we realized there was a soil difference occurring in the scarp wall that was revealed after SU-5902. This soil difference appeared to be an ancient looters pit and accounts for the artifacts lying opposite the surface slope.

SU-5904 was closed out once we revealed the boundaries of the 'ancient looters pit'. We will now assign this 'ancient looters pit' SU-5905 and excavate it since it is a newer context than the soil that was cut into by it.

The start of this 'ancient looters pit' also signals the end of surface wash material and the start of reliable strata.
