Description: SU 7003 is a debris context
and was excavated using small picks and
trowels. The soil type is very loose
and ashy* with stony inclusions including
plaster, pottery, and stone, ranging from
pebbles to cobble in size. Localized in
the North West corner is an ashy ^{soft} section
which stands out from the sandier
colored SU.
