Description: SU 7011 is a surface clearing unit from the eastern part of the trench. This area was previously excavated by the DA and contains two N-S walls (7011-01; 7011-02) with architectural Fall debris between. We scraped off any hard winter crust from the very soft - light tan to brown debris, which contains large pieces of tile, stones (cobble-boulder) and mortar fragments.

Few artefacts other than mortar fragments and tile were recovered.
