Description: SU 7016 contains material (soft, sandy tan/powder white) from within and around fallen architectural debris between walls 7011-f1 and 7011-f2, which form the corridor west of the room excavated by the DOA.

DOA excavations left this ~~area~~ <sup>area</sup> ~~excavated~~ <sup>partially</sup> and within fallen debris. This debris is very similar to that within SU 7015 to the west of wall 7011-f1. It is scraped around tumble fill of stone (cut masonry), tile within mortar plaster and plaster. Few artifacts are associated.

In the ~~South~~ <sup>South-west</sup> corner of the trench, ~~near~~ <sup>the</sup> wall 7011-f2 the level of ground is significantly lower than to west and north; it seems as though the earlier excavations in this area. There also appears to be a rodent hole going into stone rubble to north from southern SW corner of trench.

There appears to be a line - running roughly N-E - of debris tumble that seems to rest against lower debris tumble. This is indicated by a dark line on the plan view (7015-7018-21). This debris may have damaged <sup>the outer</sup> western wall (7011-f1).
