SU is beneath SU 7009 and is distinctly different
in matrix/color than the fallen architectural
debris excavated in SU 7015, 7013, 7012.

This debris is brown/grey and less compact
than very hard fallen architectural debris
beneath SU 7015 within soft tan/white sandy material.
