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Description: SU 7020 contains very soft material/soil surrounding large (cobble-boulder) stones, fragments of mortar and some tile located between north-south running walls 7011-f1 and 7011-f2. This is very similar to (if not the same as) SU 7018. We changed SUs because we were below the top of wall 7011-f1 (which was damaged by SU 7018) and because the stones appear w/in this unit to have fallen more to the north from the south. Very likely the fall of this debris is the same as that above it in SU 7018. It is distinct from ~~the~~ jungle of stone/tile and mortar to its north-east in that it has a very fine light brown/tan color <sup>ed</sup> soil in contrast to the soil material surrounding jungle to North-east, which is more granular <sup>in texture and</sup> darker brown. ~~This area to~~ <sup>SU 7020</sup> ~~was~~ we excavated down to this material and stopped.
