Description: Su 7024 contains more fill

Below 7020 ^{is} but likely part of same event/collapse ^{is}, slightly earlier or before.

appears ^{to be} to have very soft fill / architectural debris and it extends to northern part of still undamaged secondary door frame ^{en} ^{Reinforcement}

that abuts the western face of wall 7011-12.

The su consists of very large masonry stones and soft fill (tight sand) and fragments of huge ^{mortar} ~~masonry~~ slab/block.

The ~~stone block~~ sits ^{above} ^{this} tile / soft fill (su 7024)

and within its ^{eastern} ^{oddly} extent it includes large stone that sits perpendicularly to wall 7011-12

It appears that this stone is not a part of the cemented extended door jamb. (7026-1)

The stone block also is above another lens of architectural fill that appears to be oriented from NW to SE. (su 7026)
