Description: SU 7029 contains architectural debris that was between, ~~to~~ and partially over, wall 7011-11, and the fallen architectural block <sup>in</sup> 7025. The soil matrix is very soft, loose with fine texture ~~and~~ with stone, and plaster fragments.

This is later, above SU 7025 (stone block) ~~and~~. It is likely ~~and~~ probably a part of architectural fall that we excavated in 7018 and 7020. It sits above darker brown + granular fill layer excavated in SU 7033.
