Description: SU 7030 contains fill/debris layer with loose, fine brown soil and many stones<sup>(cobbles)</sup> and small fragments of plaster mortar. We excavated it from area north of door jamb/wall stub 7026-f1 and between walls 7011-f1 and 7011-f2. We drew an arbitrary <sup>E-W</sup> line between the northern face of 7026-f1 and wall 7011-f1. While the fill appeared to be the same we separated on account of the architecture.
