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Description: SU 7034 contains fragments of
pointed wall plaster ~~and~~ and stone (small - pebble - small
corbels) and bits of plaster mortar. ^{in soft matrix of soil} It appears
to be redeposited(?) debris, perhaps within foundation
trench / construction trench for wall 7011-12 and
door jamb 7026-1.

It is directly below debris fill 7032
and appears to have ^{disturbed} cut a surface to its
west (SU 7032 f1). It also appears to
have been mortared* over (although this ^{floor} broken in
many places and the fill below is breaking
through the top.)

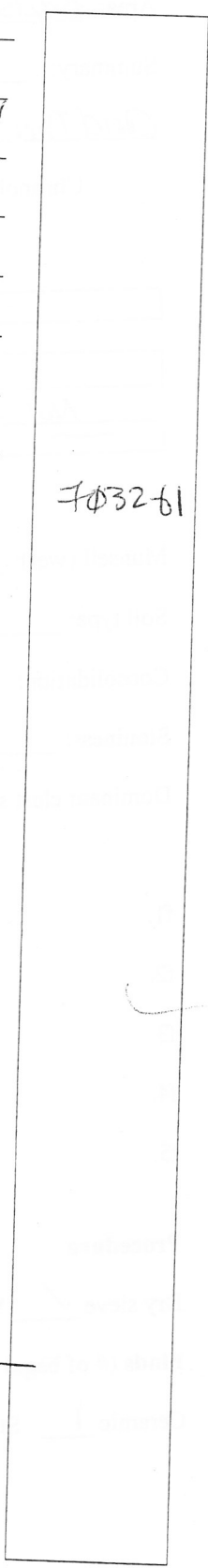

It also seems that if this possible
foundation trench cut the surface 7032-f1
it is likely to have been refilled with fill / floor packing
debris ~~from~~ below the surface levels. (?)
Patchy surface is also visible in NW sector
of the floor (uncovered by D&A excavations).

Perhaps the solidly compacted floor was
cut / disturbed to put in walls 7011-11 and 7011-12
and then ~~was~~ reused w/new walls ~~as~~ as floor-
packing ~~to~~ under ^a layer for ^a higher paved floor.

from corridor to annex room in wall 7011-12

This threshold stone imprint is ~~is~~ can be seen on

patchy lime surface. ^{The} Annex room floor to east is significantly
higher in elevation, ^(approx. 30 cm) suggesting that it may be
above earlier structure in that area as well?
