Description: This SU contains the same soil as 7116 - very sandy, silty - & removes the floor packing immediately beneath the floor. While we ~~initially~~ initially thought we'd come down on 1 or 2 foundation trenches, this did not happen. Instead we came down on loose, clayey soil across the whole SU. Closed at this point - though we overcut it ~~in~~ some, I think, since we clearly came into the silty clay in 7118.
