**Relations:** This locus together with L04G-010 are covering the area below L04G-007. all of them may be related into one fall with later fill but we could define a line (not very clear) where the matrix becomes harder with more bricks material (in locus L04G-010). Based on this line we create the diffrentiation between these two loci. since in L04G-010 area we found the head of W04G-012 it could be that the bricks which fell from this wall covers the area of L04G-010 and this is why it is different than our locus here L04G-009. At some point we thought that we can see astrait line of bricks between the loci but it was not consistent and no bricks wall could be determained. At the bottom of the locus we could see the lower level of the wall to its west W9975.
