Matrix: Small to medium stones (15-40 cm) creating most of this small wall with some smaller stones in between.

Relations: This wall was found in a very bad shape. We could trace it only along 80 cm with no continuation to any other wall. All the soil around it relates to L04G-010 with the wall standing like an island in the NE corner of the locus. We did find a lot of mudbrick material around it and also in the baulk to the east of it. The direction of the wall is North-South. The bottom of it can not be seen yet. This wall may probably belong to phase 9, considering its height.
