Summary _____

Opened: To excavate stratified accumulation previously identified as NW corner of [W9408].

Limits (N) Bounded by the unexcavated material below [W9085] to the North.

- (S) Bounded by the upper mudbrick courses of W18010 to the South
- (E) Bounded by the mudbrick facing of [W9408] to the East
- (W) Bounded by the unexcavated material below W9510 to the West.

Closed: Not closed, end of season

Matrix: Sandy orange brown mudbrick material with few small 5-10cm fieldstones, many Kurkar bits, some pottery + little shell.

Relations: [L18011] is covered by the previously excavated [L9538]. [L9538] was defined as mudbricks and later renamed [W9408]. [L18011] was not covered by these bricks however, but represents an area of stratified accumulation previously thought to be a large brick. [L18011] reaches the mudbrick exterior of [W9408] to the East, and the northern face of [W18010] to the South. The material of [L18011] continues into the unexcavated material below W9510 to the West and below W9085 to the North. It should be noted that [L18011] reaches the upper mudbrick courses, not the lower stone courses of W18010.

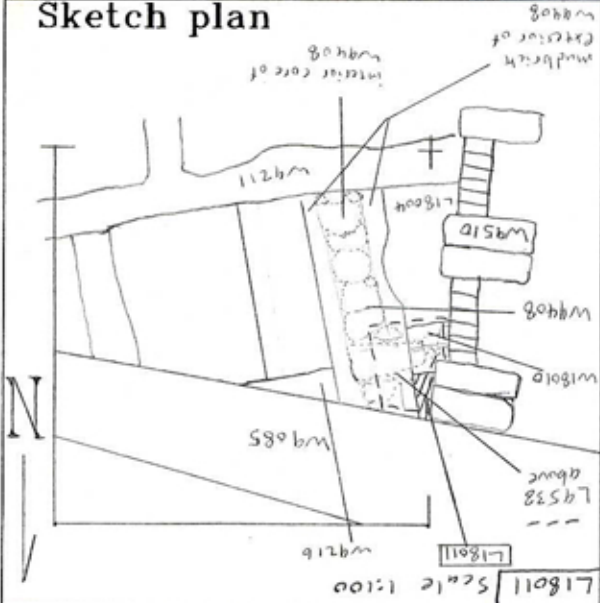
Additional Observations/Value: Very small locus reaching Phase 7 mudbrick walls.
