Summary

Opened: when L18008 came down on F18008 covering most of the locus. L18019 was opened to include make-up of F18008 and the material below.

Limits (N) Bounded by material below W9066 to the North. (W9400 + L18031, which were excavated after L18019).

(S) Bounded by previously excavated material in SQA332 to the South.

(E) Bounded by previously excavated material in SQA533 to the East. (L9852)

(W) Bounded by L9720 to the West.

Closed: Came down on F18019, material below F18019 left unnumbered at end of season.

Matrix: Locus is a thin layer of grey material mixed with sandy mudbrick material containing pottery, bone, shell, and flecks of charcoal. F18008 is a thin white to grey ashy plaster floor. F18019 is a thin white plaster floor.

Relations: L18019 is covered by L18008 and sealed by F18008. L18019 will cover the unnumbered locus below, which F18019 will seal. L18019 is cut by L9720 (excavated '91 season) to the West. To the East, L18019 is the cont. of the previously excavated material of L9410. L18019 cuts and covers the mudbrick material above the ^{stair} base of W9400 to the North. To the South, L18019 is the cont. of the previously excavated material of L9852 and L9867. F18019 is cut by L9720 ^{on the west} reaches W9400 ^{on the north} extends below W9065 to the East in SQA532/33, and probably extended into SQA332 to the South although the matrix of F18019 was not noticed when this square was excavated in '93. The loci in SQA332 where F18019 was not noticed were L9852 - 14.00 + 13.69 and L9867 below. F18019 does not relate to W9066, but rather to W9400 below W9066, so F18019 extends below W9066 at a much lower level than the bottom level of W9066. F18019 appears to be the continuation of F9154 in SQA533 to the East (levels + matrix are similar), with L9410 West of W9065 in SQA533 the continuation of the matrix of L18019.

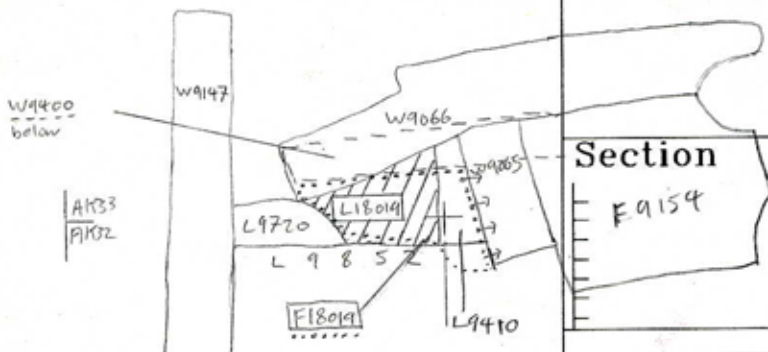
