Opened: CAME DOWN ON F18018 WHILE EXCAVATING L18018. FLOOR MATRIX AND FILL BELOW CHANGED TO L18025

Closed: CAME DOWN ON DESTRUCTION AND WE DECIDED TO EXCAVATE ONLY THE NORTHERN PORTION COLLAPSED TABS WITH L18017, L18020, AND L18007 TO L18025

Matrix: GREY AND WHITE KURKAR SURFACE. SOIL BELOW FLOOR IS DARK BROWN WITH SOME ASH AND LITTLE POTTERY. SAME AS L18009 TO THE NORTH. L18025 DIFFERS FROM ORANGESAND REDS IN DESTRUCTION L18033 BELOW.

Relations: L18018 COMES DOWN ON A ^{patchy} F18018 WHICH COVERS BUT DOES NOT SEAL L18025. L18025 CONTINUES NORTH AS L18009. L18025 CONTINUES UNDER ~~AND~~ BY W9964 TO THE WEST. L18025 REACHES THE HIGHEST MUDBRICK COURSE OF W9715. L18025 COVERS BUT DOES NOT SEAL L18033. L18025 continues into the East bulk.

Like L18009 and L18020 L18025 is mudbrick leveling fill laid over the destruction deposit. On top of this fill F18016 + F18018 (probably = F9727 in A132) were laid and W9963, W9964 and W9709 were built on top of that surface. L18071 THOUGH NOT MUDBRICK MATERIAL WAS MOST LIKELY PART OF THIS LEVELING FILL, OVER WHICH WAS LAID F18024.

Additional Observations/Value: MUDBRICK FILL BELOW SCRAPPY FLOOR. LOW VALUE
