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Summary _____

Opened: Removed portion of W9066 West of East face of W9065. [L18031] opened to excavate material below W9066.

- Limits (N) Bounded by L18015 to the North.
 (S) Bounded by L18019 to the South.
 (E) Bounded by unexcavated material below W9066 to the East.
 (W) Bounded by L9725 to the West (excavated '91).

Closed: Came down on W9400.

Matrix: Brown mudbrick material with kurkar bits in South of locus, grey brown soil with some ash + charcoal in North of Locus.

Relations: [L18031] is covered by W9066. W9066 is only preserved to one course high in the western half of the locus, which does not allow W9066 to seal L18031 since three years have elapsed since W9066 was uncovered in AK33 during which time erosional intrusion may have occurred. [L18031] covers W9400, which is actually the continuation of the material of L18031. [L18031] also covers F18015 at its northern limit and contains the continuation of the material of L18015. To the East L18031 technically continues into the unexcavated material below W9066, but in reality L18031 does not exist, it is the misidentified upper reaches of W9400 with W9066 built on + cutting W9400 below. The continuation of the material of L18015 in [L18031] also continues below W9066. To the South, F18019 reaches [L18031] since [L18031] is actually the material of W9400. L18031 is cut by L9725 to the West.

Additional Observations/Value: Technical division between Phase 6 wall cutting and covering Phase 7 wall. No Value
