Summary

Opened: opened L18050 to excavate below F18038.

Limits (N) L18049, L9981, L9980

(S) 9727 and 9737

(E) Bank of AH32

(W) L18052

Closed: L18050 closed when all matrix of F18038 and its levelling fill below was removed and the matrix became what we call "destruction-y." collapsed L18048 and L18050 to form destruction L18058.

Matrix: opened L18060 as unsealed area of destruction above installation L9982.

Matrix: Compact grey ash floor with brown compact earth below.

Special Finds #180737 Slingstone #180735 Small Vessel. All pottery dated to IR1 with some mB intrusions of painted pottery sherds.

Relations: L18050 is covered and sealed by F18038 Above.

To the North, L18050 continues into L18049, L9981 and L9980, the floor makeup of all <sup>these</sup> loci and their fill below to destruction are all the same, and at similar elevations. A post-destruction levelling <sup>and fill</sup> construction of a compact living surface accounts for this similarity.

To the south, L18050 continues into the floor makeup of L9727, and its immediate fill below <sup>to destruction</sup> L9737.

To the east, L18050 continues into the bank with AH32.

To the west, L18050 reaches L18052, the destruction layer and has the same stratigraphic position as L18028 and L18039 above L18052.

L18050 covers and seals the destruction layer below: L18058 and part of L18060 to the west.

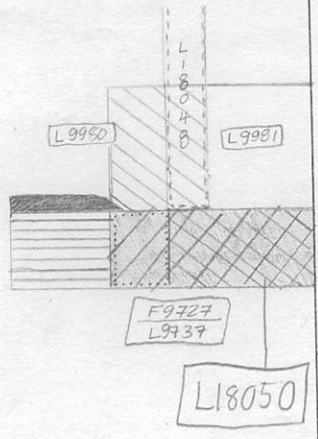
Additional Observations/Value: L18050 has high value for being the last levelling surface to the destruction layer immediately below.
