Summary \_\_\_\_\_

Opened: When L18053 reached level of L9985 (93 season) and these two loci of similar matrices were collapsed to form L18054.

Limits (N) Bounded by unexcavated material below W9085 and W9216 to the North.

(S) Bounded by W9211 to the South

(E) Bounded by the unexcavated material below L18084 to the East.

(W) Bounded by L18059 and W9408 to the West.

Closed: Not closed. End of season.

Matrix: semi-loose grey sandy material with intermittent Kurkar bits, charcoal flecks, some ash, with a medium amount of pottery, bone, and shell.

Relations: L18054 is covered by L18053 and L9985. L18054 is the continuation below of the matrix of these loci. L18054 reaches W9211 to the South, is the continuation of the material of L18059 to the SW, reaches W9408 to the West and continues in the unexcavated material below W9085 and W9216 to the North and below L18084 to the East. L18054 and L9985 above maybe a fauza or pit into which the "cult" assemblage of 9903 was tossed, however, the majority of the pottery from L18054, L9985 and L18059 is earlier than the "cult" pottery of L9903. The small amount of cult pottery in L9985 may be the result of post depositional shift or movement and not result from primary deposition. Since no floors were observed in the matrix of L9985 + L18054, further excavation of L18084 and the floors below is required in order to <sup>better</sup> understand the stratigraphy and pottery sequence of this locus/area. This will still not completely account for the temporal/depositional position of the "cult" pottery of L9903, since it was not found above the mudbrick platform/floor of L18065, but to the West of it above L9985 in the matrix of L9903. Further discussion of this problem on card for L18065.

Additional Observations/Value: Phase 8/9 locus reaching Phase 8/9 wall of unresolved relation to L9903 - the "cult" locus Very High Value.

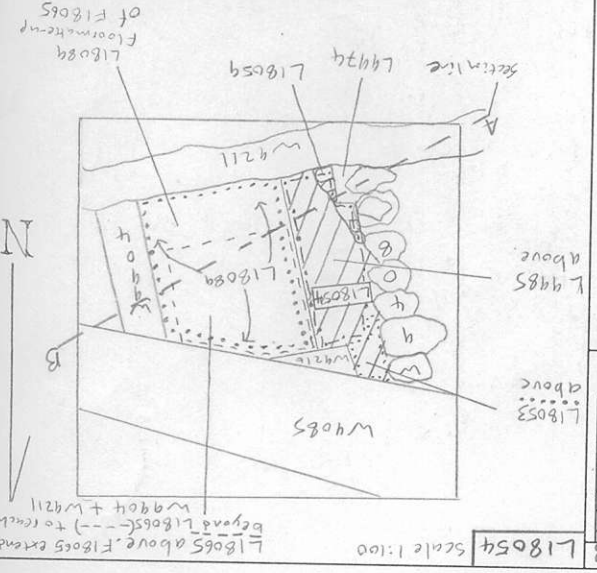

**Sketch plan**

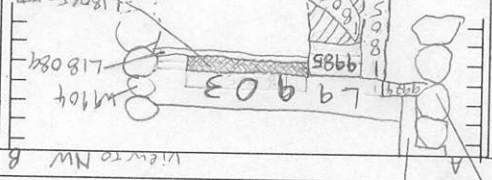
