Opened: L18060 was closed when top and interior trough of L9982 (the installation) were cleared of debris.

L18069 was opened E of L9982 to search for the presumed top of bin L18073.

Limits (N) L18058

(S) L9779, L9795

(E) L18058

(W) L9982

Closed: Reached top of Bin 18073; split into bin and debris surrounding it, L18072

Matrix: Destruction material; powdery orange soil with charcoal flecks and possibly calcined stone material. Same as 18060 above, 18058 to N + E and L18072 below.

Relations: L18060 covers but does not seal L18069; however, F18038 above does seal the destruction material above 18069 and so also L18069.

To the north L18069 continues into L18058

To the south L18069 continues into L9779 and/or 9795 (below).

To the east L18069 continues into L18058

To the west L18069 reaches L9982 (installation)

L18069 covers, but does not seal, L18072 and L18073 below.


