Summary				

Opened: Opened L18075 to delineate the side of the installation L9982, and to reach the "destruction floor" below, to elucidate its connection to L9982.

Limits (N) L18058
(E) Pedestal below L18049
(W) L18090, L9982

Closed: End of season - defined floor.

Matrix: Brown compact earth with a few double-fist sized fieldstones. Came down upon Ash-grey flooring like that in L18058, probably the same floor, continuing into one another. Not much destruction - about this locus, other than floor connections.

Relations: L18075 is covered, but not sealed by L9980 and L9978 above, which were dug in previous seasons.

To the north, L18075 continues into the pedestal below W9262. Unwise of F18075's continuation. To the south, L18075 is different than the matrix of L18058. And may reach L18058 or just be un-fired fallen material from destruction. However, F18075 continues into L18058.

To the east F18075 continues into the unexcavated material below L18049. F18075 may reach stone pavement F18090, and reaches the installation L18075.

To the west, L18075 continues into L18090A.

Defined floor to the best of our ability but ran out of time - closed end of season.

Limits (N) pedestal below W9262.
 (S) L18058

 Closed: End of season - defined floor.

Matrix: Brown compact earth with a few double-fist sized fieldstones. Came down upon Ash-grey Flooring like that in L18058, probably the same floor. Continuing into one another. Not much destruction - about this locus, other than floor connections.

Relations: L18075 is covered, but not sealed by L9980 and L9978 above, which were dug in previous seasons.
 To the north, L18075 continues into the pedestal below W9262. Unsure if F18075's continuation.
 To the south, L18075 is different than the matrix of L18058, and may reach L18058 or just be unfired fallen material from destruction. However, F18075 continues into L18058.
 To the east, F18075 continues into the unfired material below L18049.
 To the west, L18075 continues into L18090A ^{F18075 may reach} stone pavement F18090, and reaches the installation L9982.

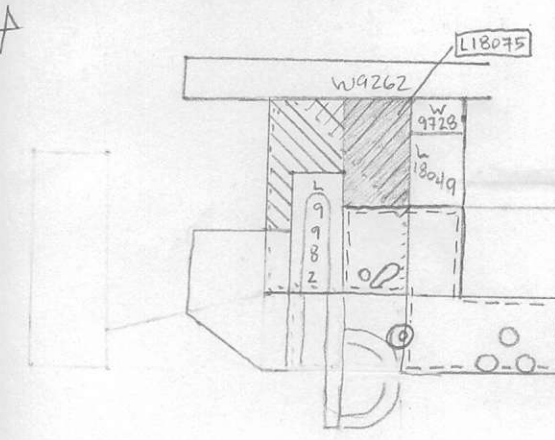
Defined floor to the best of our ability but ran out of time - closed end of season.
