Summary

Opened: While excavating L18230, came down on wall rubble in the north. Changed to L18249 in the north, and [L18241] south.

Limits (N) L18249

(S) Balk

(E) W18250, L18293

(W) Balk

Closed: Came down on floor with vessels in situ. Small area with no floor excavated at L18307.

Matrix: Loose medium stream sandy soil with some Kankar inclusions

Relations: Above: L18230 covers and continues down into [L18241]

North: [L18241] reaches rubble L18241(?)

South: [L18241] continues into the balk.

East: [L18241] reaches W18250, and continues into L18293.

West: [L18241] continues into the balk.

Below: [L18241] comes down on a uncertain floor. It was covered on the east side by restorable vessels, but we were not able to define much more than a hard packed surface of some kind under these vessels and extending west. An area on the west that did not show evidence of this surface was excavated as [L18307].

L18241 reaches W18250, continues north into L18249, and south + west into the balk. L18241 also continues east as L18293

Additional Observations/Value: High value.
