F18247 WAS NOT OBSERVED IN THE WEST BUT <sup>only</sup> IN THE EAST. F18247 IS MORE OF A SURFACE THAN A FLOOR.

Relations: LOCUS ABOVE: F18209 CONTINUES INTO L18247. THE ELEVATION OF F18209 IS 14.06-13.76M SO F18209 CONTINUES 4.1M INTO F18247. LOCUS BELOW: F18247 AND F18247 COVER BUT DO NOT SEAL L18278. PLASTER PATCH<sup>IN MATRIX</sup> FIRST MENTIONED IN MATRIX OF L18209 AT 13.77M CONTINUES DOWN THROUGH F18247, L18278 AND TO F18278 AT 13.40M.

Note: L9950, L18209 and L18247 contain mixed material because it was not realized that their respective floors sloped down from north to south, while we excavated them as horizontal floors. For this reason L9950, L18209 and L18247 are mixed and contaminate each other. Only those baskets whose beginning elevations are below ca. 13.71 should be considered clean.

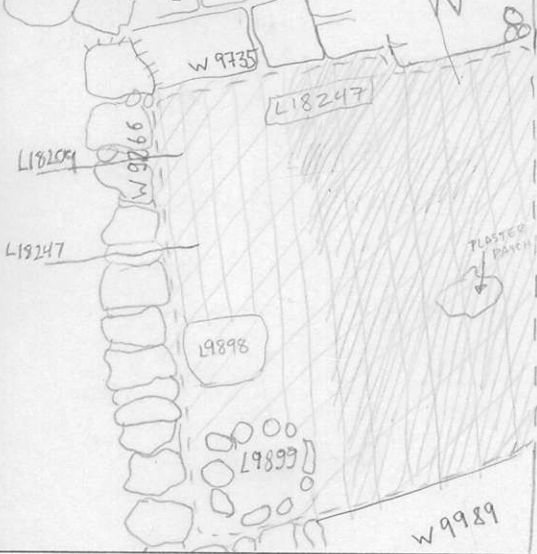

Sketch plan



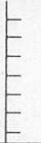
