Summary

Opened: While excavating L18230, came down on yellow mudbrick debris and rubble in the Wash. This area became L18249 and the rest is L18241.

Limits (N) Balk under W9065

(S) L18241

(E) L18239, W9909

(W) W9998

Closed: Came down on F18249 = F18241. End of season reached

Matrix: Yellow karak mudbrick debris and first sized rubble from W9998 (probably).

Relations: Above: L18230 covers but does not seal L18249.

North: L18249 continues into the balk under W9065.

South: L18249 is reached by L18241.

East: L18249 is reached by L18239 and reaches W9909.

West: L18249 reaches W9998. L18249 is most likely rubble from W9998 for two reasons. First the yellow matrix matches the color of most bricks in W9998. Second, W9998 is badly damaged and most of the west face is gone, as opposed to the well preserved W9909.

Below: L18249 comes down on F18249 = F18241.

F18249 continues into F18239 and then into the balk. F18249 reaches the sector of W9909 to the east and W18250 to the west. F18249 continues south as F18241.

8/02 perhaps this is collapsed mudbrick from over the doorway, comparable to L18293.

Additional Observations/Value: High Value. Destruction Deposit.
