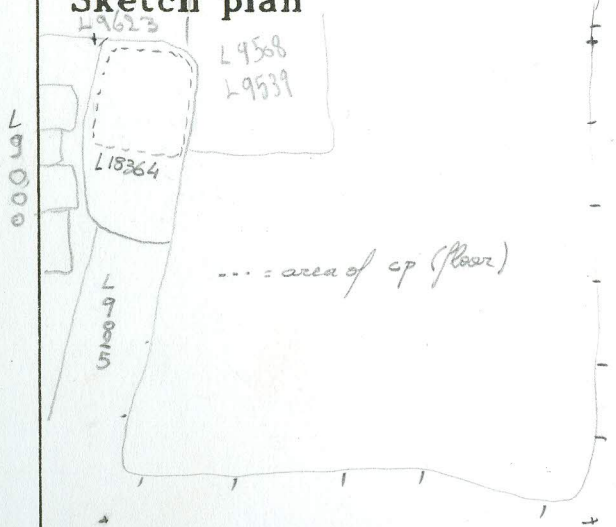

 EAST: POSSIBLE MATCHES WITHIN THE RANGE OF OUR MEASUREMENTS ARE LOC 9050/9165/9259. HOWEVER L9508/9539/9623 MIGHT BE THE BEST CANDIDATES. L9508 (14.85-14.68) HAS A MATRIX OF HARD WHITISH GREY SOIL BUT NO FLOOR, L9539 (14.68-13.45) WHICH IS BELOW L9508 HAS LOOSER WHITE MATERIAL IN ITS EASTERN SIDE. L9623 WHICH IS WEST OF L9539 (14.28-14.23) HAS A FLOOR OUT OF GREY MATERIAL AND MAY BE BEST FITTING.
 WEST: L18364 CONTINUES IN THE BALK
 BELOW: L18364 HAS NO RELATIONS BELOW YET and never will as the rest of the over hanging balt of which it was a part was purposefully collapsed for safety reasons.
