Opened: START OF THE SEASON WE OPENED L18372 WHEN L18371 WAS BROUGHT DOWN TO THE LEVEL OF THE SOUTHERN PART OF L18339

Limits (N) BALK UNDER W9065 AND L18370, W9909

Closed: WE CAME DOWN ON A FRAGMENTARY FLOOR F18372

Matrix: DARK GREY TO LOOSE BROWN SOIL DOWN TO WHITE FIBER-LIKE FLOOR MATERIAL OR GREY-BLUE FLOOR PATCHES WITH CHARCOAL FRAGMENTS. SOME MORE RED BROWN MATERIAL NEAR SOUTHERN BALK. While tracing the floor it became apparent that there are probably at least 3-5 close resurfacings. Floor is either white/ashy or turtury, depending on resurfacing.

Relations: ABOVE: L18339 AND L18371 ARE COVERING (BUT DO NOT SEAL) L18372
 NORTH: THE FILL OF L18372 CONTINUES IN THE BALK UNDER W9065 AND REACHES W9909. F18372 CONTINUES IN THAT BALK BUT DOES NOT REACH W9909.
 SOUTH: L18372 CONTINUES IN THE BALK
 EAST: L18372 REACHES W18250 VERY CLEARLY IN THE SE CORNER OF L18372
 WEST: L/F 18372 CONTINUES IN THE BALK AND THE FILL REACHES W9998 BUT NOT THE FLOOR
 BELOW: L18394 IS COVERED BY L18372

Floor:
 North: F18372 may continue into multi-floors of L18370 + L18372
 South: F18372 continues into balk
 East: a small turtury patch of upper Most F18372 reached W18250 in SE corner of locus. It was not possible to trace the white/ashy floors to W18250. In some cases the floor could be traced to within a few cm of the wall, but then there would be a gap. However, it seems likely that these earlier floors reached W18250 as they often seem to slope up a bit in that direction
 West: Probably continues into balk.

Additional Observations/Value: No significant material, but does reach W18250

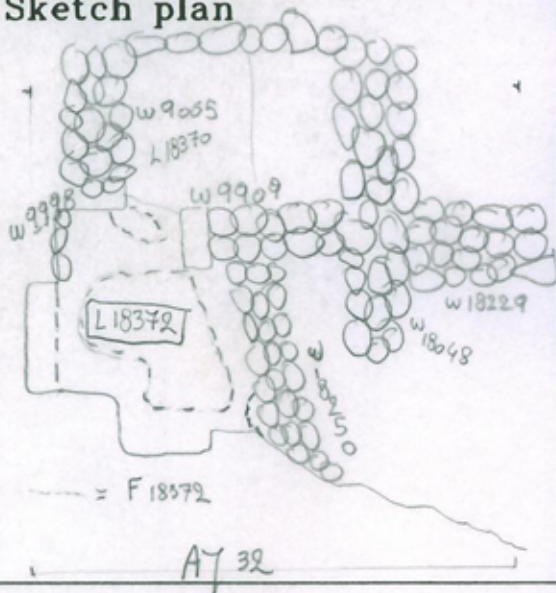
