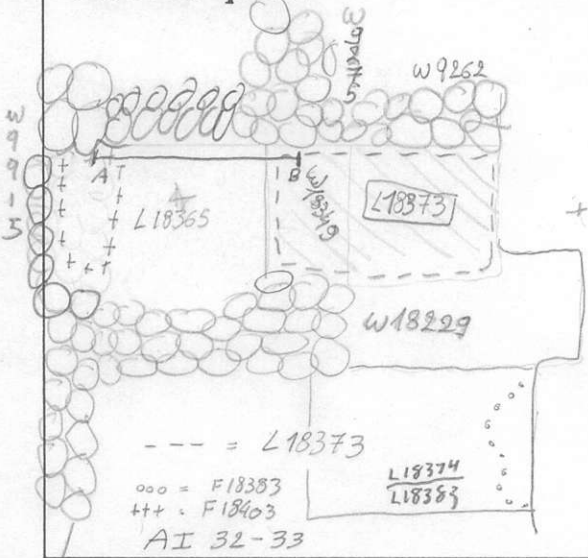

Sketch plan

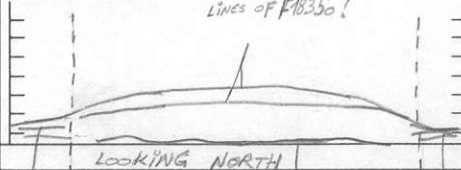
