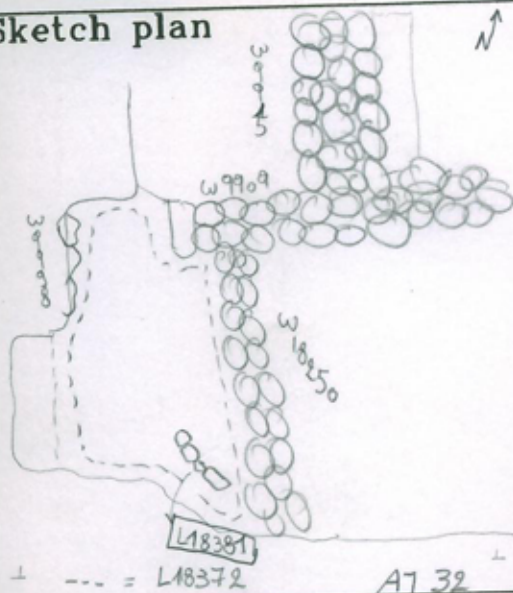
L18381 may be a narrow, fragile "wall" sitting on F18372. It does not seem strong enough to have been more than one course high, or to have functioned as a container or a retaining wall. No traces of burning were found on the stones, or on the adjacent floor, or in the fill. Its purpose remains elusive

Sketch plan

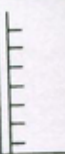
