Closed: WE CAME DOWN TO BOTTOM LEVEL OF TEST TRENCH L18379, ADJACENT TO THE EAST AND COLLAPSED BOTH INTO L18392

Matrix: HORIZONTAL LAYERS OF SOFT BLACK MATERIAL AND PURE YELLOW SAND ARE PRESENT. THE WHOLE MATRIX IS VERY SOFT. THE SAND IS NOT STERILE AND CONTAINS A FAIR AMOUNT OF POTTERY AND BONE. A FEW DOUBLEHEAD SIZE STONES APPEAR IN THE EAST WHICH APPEARED ALL TO BE FLOATING AFTER CLEANING AND WERE CONSIDERED FALLEN RUBBLE FROM AN UNKNOWN WALL *

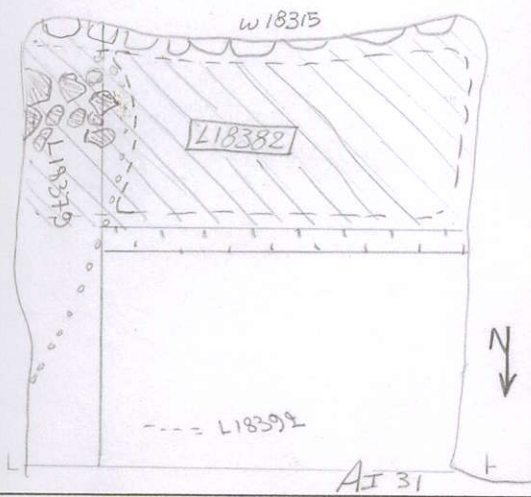

 ! THIS LOCUS IS DISTURBED BY A PIT CLEARLY VISIBLE IN THE EAST BALK. THE RUBBLE APPEARS TO BE PART OF THE FILL OF THE PIT (= L18399). WE NOTED THIS FEATURE ONLY AFTER THE CLOSING OF [L18382].
