Summary _____

Opened: L18393 came down on a several fist to headsize stones and we opened L18400 below. Originally thought L18400 was a wall

Limits (N) BALK UNDERNEATH W9400

(S) BALK UNDERNEATH W9909

(E) F18403

(W) L18409

Closed: END OF SEASON AND CAME DOWN ON F18403

Matrix: L18400 consists out of head- or fist size stones closely together in the SE corner but, however, irregular laid out, with in between red soil or some red mudbrick material. On top of the stones was a 5-10 cm thick layer of mudbrick with some white reed matting in which might point to bricks. 2 rimless vessels lay in the west.

Relations: ABOVE: L18393 continues down into pit seal L18400

NORTH: THE FILL OF L18400 CONTINUES INTO THE BALK BUT NO STONES ARE VISIBLE IN THE NORTH GOING INTO THE BALK

SOUTH: THE FILL OF L18400 GOES BELOW W9909 BUT NO STONES CONTINUE INTO THAT BALK.

EAST: THE STONES ARE PLACED AGAINST THE LOWEST COURSE OF W9915 BUT DO NOT CONTINUE BELOW THE WALL. SINCE L18400 IS A PIT, IT POSSIBLY CUT THE FLOOR WHICH IS EXTENDING UNDER W9915 AND WHICH MIGHT BE EQUATED WITH F18403.

WEST: L18400 CUTS L18409

BELOW: L18400 COVERS BUT DOES NOT SEAL F18403 (= F18365) WHICH CONTINUED UNDERNEATH W9915 TO THE WEST.

L18400 was first thought to be a wall since L18393 came down on several stones. Yet, in L18409 the floor was still cut in the east as in L18398 and L18390 and L18375 above. This means that the loop to their east are all part of the same pit cutting through the floors.

L18400 may well disturb L18409 as no +z was kept

The surly photographer would only reveal that photo #s were somewhere in the range of 185259 and 185277

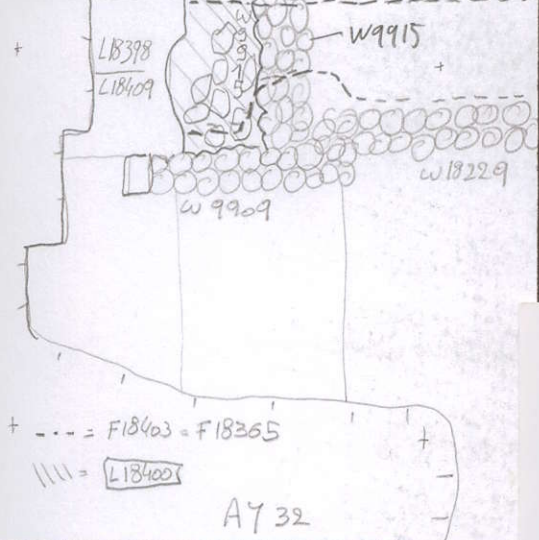
Additional Observations/Value: MEDIUM VALUE. Vaguely outlined "pit"
