summary:

Opened: Start of 2000 excavation season

Limits (N) Test trench from 1999

(S) Test trench from 1999 L18379 (eastern 25%) and L18341 (western 75%)

(E) Baulk

(W) Western extent of baulk material

Closed: Reached plaster and charcoal of L18353 / L18352 preserved to south.

Matrix: Grey, ashy, with potsherds, shells and some charcoal. Horizontal sand and ash lenses.

Relations: Probably a continuation of L18391 in test trench (1999) to north. Pedestal brought down to surface of stratified material to the south (F18353) = L18445 to NW.

This was a baulk which stood through several seasons, and was excavated down periodically.
There is no locus # for material above.

Importance: Low value. Baulk exposed during winter with little pottery.

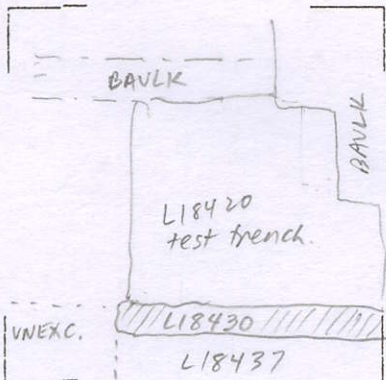
